Why a course on Sexuality and SRHR?

Sexuality and Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights (SRHR) are central aspects of people's lives, yet a gap exists in their access to accurate information and services regarding these matters. Due to the sensitive and taboo nature of the topics, there is confusion and/or silence around issues like consent, sexual and gender identities, contraception, violence and abuse, body image, disability and sexuality, gender norms and roles, etc. Such topics are often not included as a part of professional training courses or of sexuality education in schools. This online course aims to provide interested individuals the resources to understand and address these issues from a rights-based perspective.



What the course entails

Adapted from TARSHI's [Basics and Beyond](#) training manual by a team of experts, the course is an introduction to sexuality and sexual and reproductive health (SRH) from a **rights-based** and **affirmative** perspective. The course enhances facilitation skills and provides resources for trainers that can be adapted accordingly for the trainings in their own groups.



Course update

The course is offered in two parts. Part 1, *Basics and Beyond Online Course on Sexuality and SRHR* and Part 2, *Beyond Basics Online Course on Sexuality and SRHR*. Part 1 addresses foundational level concepts around sexuality, gender and SRHR and is a pre-requisite for Part 2 which gives an introduction to sexual and reproductive rights by addressing them in the context of human rights. The course is in English and comprises three modules each. This announcement pertains to the registration for **Part 1 only** during the celebratory offer period.



Who this course is for

This course is recommended for SRHR practitioners, service providers, trainers as well as students and teachers of social work and social sciences, and anyone interested in these topics. It has been and can be used by a variety of people interested in learning about issues of gender and sexuality to be able to work on Sexuality and SRHR in various professional settings.



Advantages of an online course

Being an online course, it is suited to distance learning and is flexible. It can be accessed from anywhere, anytime with an internet connection, which makes it a convenient and cost-effective learning tool. In the current times, because of the COVID pandemic, more people have adapted to the online mode as an opportunity for continued learning as a lot of onsite trainings have had to be cancelled or postponed.



Benefits to learners

Learners who complete the course diligently can expect to gain an in-depth understanding of the basics of gender and sexuality, sexual and reproductive health and rights. Learner responses will be analysed to gauge the level of engagement with the topics, and the level of understanding of sexuality and SRH from a rights-based perspective. After a qualitative analysis of responses by experts in the field of SRHR, eCertificates of Completion or of Excellence will be awarded. The course does NOT certify learners to become sexuality educators/trainers, and may not be used as such.
